1. Why do we put graphics in scientific publications?
2. Characteristics of good graphics.
3. The creative process in the visual presentation of results.
4. Tools for creating graphics from ready-made elements available online.
5. Basics of preparing graphics from photographic materials.
6. Use of MS Office elements to create simple vector graphics.

Teaching methods:

Hands-on workshop at the computer; MS Office software, GIMP 2.10 or later, graphics tools accessible from the browser.
